At the end of last year we had 208 members, as of right now we have 185, with 20 more paid, but forms haven't been filled out.

Our first time doing the Open House Book Fair seemed to go very smoothly! While there were more boxes and crates than we anticipated, it was fairly easy to roll out into the cafeteria and unload.

Special thanks to Blake, Jill, Makenzie and Arya for their help setting up! And the pack up went very smoothly - we were out of the school by 7.

The financial forms were just released and we had about \$3700 in sales. Since we did not pass the \$3800 threshold, we will receive our profit in Scholastic Dollars which we can spend at the February fair to restock the book vending machine or if One Book is available through the scholastic catalog we could purchase it with some of those profits. With this fair we have added \$1482.78 in Scholastic Dollars to our account. Since we had no idea how busy this fair would be and were just hoping to earn the bonus for our February Fair which we did, I think it was a success!
